

Are SUA researchers prepared to grab 1 billion from MoEST!

Minister for Education, Science, and Technology, Prof. Aldof Mkenda announced during the Budget Speech an incentive of 50 million shillings for science and medical researchers who will be able to publish the results of their research in the high rank journals in the world. Examples of the top journals are Nature or Lancet.

Our simple analysis has shown that Tanzania researchers have published 25 jointly journal papers with other collaborators found in different countries. The publications which have been done come from life sciences, physical sciences and earth and environmental sciences subjects.

These research outputs for Tanzania researchers have been published between 1st October 2021 – 30th September 2022 and indexed by Nature Index.


